OUR MISSION

Brooklyn Workforce Innovations (BWI) helps jobless and working poor New Yorkers establish careers in sectors that offer good wages and opportunities for advancement. BWI's mission is to empower low- and moderate-income people by creating living-wage employment opportunities and access to career paths. Currently BWI helps men and women start careers in commercial driving, low voltage cable installation, TV and film production, and skilled woodworking. The organization also leads an innovative partnership with the New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA), through which BWI trains public housing residents for upwardly-mobile jobs with NYCHA. BWI also leads employer-customized training initiatives and, for those at the earliest phases of job readiness, offers free Driver's License access paired with career development support.

All of BWI's programs use a long-term, wrap-around approach that considers each trainee's needs and strengths, and removes barriers to employment. We focus on helping people access industry-recognized certifications, and every trainee is offered free financial coaching, on-site public benefits access and advocacy, and other supports that take our work far beyond training and job placement.

BWI is in its 17th year training and connecting some of the city's most disadvantaged men and women to employment. Despite a stabilizing economy, long-time economically challenged communities of New York City continue to struggle with high percentages of poverty and unemployment. Our work to prepare individuals for in-demand, sector-based employment is just as crucial as it was when BWI first began.
